

**THE 3905 CENTURY CLUB, INC.**  
**THE 12-MONTH SEQUENCE (ANNUAL) AWARD APPLICATION**  
(MIXED BANDS/MODES)  
(NOT ENDORSABLE)

**NOTE: This award is obsolete and will be archived on May 1, 2025. It may be applied for up until that date.** The 12-Month Sequence Award is earned by working a required number of contacts in a specified order during any one-year period (or less) of the applicant's choice.

**IMPORTANT NOTE: This award requires that the applicant has run at least one complete net as NCS during the one-year period. (See requirement 6i).**

**REQUIREMENTS:**

1. All applicants for this award must hold a 100-Point Certificate on at least one of the nets run by ***The 3905 Century Club, Inc.***
2. All contacts must be made on ***The 3905 Century Club, Inc.*** nets and may be on any mixture of bands and/or modes.
3. No contact made, or NCS points earned, before May 1, 2006 may be used toward this award. All QSLs applied toward this award may be used on other Club awards that do not specifically restrict their use. NCS points used toward this award are not applicable to other awards except the NCS Award(s).
4. **DO NOT** enter any call sign more than once on this application.

**NOTE:** Any call sign modified by PORTABLE or MOBILE and/or a different state, province or DX entity is considered a different call sign for the purpose of this award. (See Definitions in the Bylaws, Article VI.)

5. All contacts and NCS points applied toward this award must have been made within a one-year period of the applicant's choosing. For the purpose of this award, a year is defined as running from the beginning of the ZULU date on the first contact applied toward the award to the end of the ZULU day before that date in the following year.
6. You must submit the following required 74 contacts and 4 NCS Points earned for performing NCS duties – using any band/mode unless specified otherwise. Each category must be completed in order from 12 down to 1. All contacts in each category must be dated before all contacts in the following categories:
  - a. Twelve (12) contacts with mobiles, all in any mixture of different US states, different Canadian provinces or territories, or different DX entities.
  - b. Eleven (11) officer points for contacts with Club officers and/or appointees holding offices defined in the Officer's Award Application. Multiple points for same officer is allowed.
  - c. Ten (10) contacts with Wildcards (holders of the 1000-Point Award.) The contact does **NOT** have to be on the band/mode for which the 1000-Point Award was earned.
  - d. Nine (9) contacts with any one state, any one Canadian province or territory or any one DX entity other than Canada.
  - e. Eight (8) contacts with club stations.
  - f. Seven (7) CW contacts.
  - g. Six (6) contacts made on any PSK or RTTY net(s), all different call signs.
  - h. Five (5) contacts, each made on a different net. Early and late nets are different nets.

- i. Four (4) NCS points. (Applicant must list net, date and points earned.)
- j. Three (3) contacts with different YLs licensed for operation on The 3905CC nets.
- k. Two (2) contacts with DX entities, all different entities.
- l. One (1) combo. (Two contacts, one with each member of the combo.)

#### **SUBMITTING APPLICATIONS:**

1. After first assuring that each QSL used toward this award conforms to all of the requirements above, refer to the standard instructions contained in the application for the 100-Point Award, the SWL Award, or on our web site (Awards Program, General Information), or included with this application if it was obtained by postal mail, for submitting applications and paying awards/endorsement fees.
