THE 3905 CENTURY CLUB, INC. HIGH POINT AWARD APPLICATION

(MIXED BAND/MODE) (ENDORSABLE)

NOTE: This award is obsolete and will be archived on May 1, 2025. It may be applied for up until that date. The High Point Award is earned for submitting QSLs confirming contacts made with or from USA State Mountain Tops or Highest Points as outlined below. Two versions of the award are offered – **MOUNTAIN GOAT** and **HIKER**.

DEFINITIONS:

HIGH POINT – A location where the point is listed as the geographical location of the highest point above sea level (MSL) in a listed state. The District of Columbia is not included for the purposes of this award.

REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. All applicants for this award must hold a 3905CC 100-Point Certificate on any band/mode.
- 2. All contacts must be made on 3905 Century Club, Inc. awards nets and may be on any bands/modes.
- 3. All contacts must be made on or after **December 1, 2016**.
- 4. All QSLs applied toward this award may have been used on prior awards other than the High Point Award, and may be used on other Club awards that do not specifically restrict their use.
- QSLs must NOT be altered or augmented by the recipient. If you receive an inadequate QSL, request a replacement.
- 6. The MOUNTAIN GOAT version of this award is earned for four (4) contacts made while operating from each of ten (10) different High Points 40 QSLs required. Each QSL submitted must indicate that your location was at a specific High Point prelisted on the award application. Endorsements are available in increments of five (5) additional High Points, with four (4) confirmed contacts required while operating from each additional High Point.
- 7. The <u>HIKER</u> version of this award is earned for confirmed contacts made <u>with</u> each of fifteen (15) different High Points 15 QSLs required. Each QSL submitted must indicate that the contacted call sign was located at a specific dry High Point prelisted on the award application. Endorsements are available in increments of five (5) additional High Points, with one confirmed contact required with each additional High Point.
 - **NOTE**: The difference in the contact requirements between the "Mountain Goat" and "Hiker" versions of this award are intended to reflect the relative effort and difficulty involved in making those contacts.
- 8. Proximity It will not be always possible to operate directly on a High Point, or even within 100 yards of one. You may claim to be operating from a High Point if you are as close as you can get to the point consistent with the safety of yourself and others, **AND** you are no more than ½ mile from the actual High Point location.
- 9. The Awards Committee has NOT researched the requirements and possible pitfalls you may encounter when attempting to work every High Point. Some may represent an impossible situation for a passenger vehicle or hiker, while some others may be on restricted land that requires an entry fee or permission to access. It is your responsibility to research these details before heading out to a specific High Point.

10. If questions about interpretation of the requirements for this award arise and you cannot reach agreement with your Area Awards Manager, please contact the Awards Committee, whose decision on interpretation will be final. The Awards Committee will contact all involved parties before rendering a decision. In drafting this award the internet was used in reference to each High Point and can be referenced to the award list location.

Note: There are 50 High Points listed, one for each state. Several are in remote wooded locations while thirteen (13) are for experienced mountain hikers or climbers. There are at least twenty-nine (29) that can be accessed easily and most of those by vehicle. Several have beautiful mountain top monuments and visitor centers and some are located in State Parks with restricted hours. Good luck on your quest.
