THE 3905 CENTURY CLUB, INC. WORKED ALL CANADA AWARDS APPLICATION

(EACH BAND/MODE SEPARATELY) (SOME ENDORSABLE)

The Worked All Canada Awards are a series of awards generally paralleling the available Worked All States certificate awards. These awards may be earned for each band/mode combination for which *The 3905 Century Club, Inc.* operates a net.

DEFINITIONS:

General WAC - This refers to a WAC Award with no special conditions applied.

Specialty WAC – This refers to a defined WAC Award with special conditions such as WAC Caps, WAC YL, etc.

WAC Open – This refers to a WAC Award issued for specific special conditions not specifically spelled out in this WAC Award application.

REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. All contacts must be made on *The 3905 Century Club, Inc*. nets and must be on the same band and mode.
- 2. The applicant must hold a 100-Point Certificate for the band/mode for which any WAC or WACSSM application is submitted.
- 3. All QSLs previously applied toward other awards may also be used toward all forms of the WAC Award.
- 4. The use of Wild Cards is not permitted on any WAC or WACSSM award application.
- 5. You may claim a call sign only <u>once per province or territory</u>. For the purpose of this award, a call sign modified by a special prefix, or by a mobile or portable designator, is the same call sign, unless it is in a different province or territory.
- 6. The general **WAC AWARD** requires confirmed contacts with <u>all 13 Canadian provinces and territories</u>.
- 7. The following specialty WAC awards require contacts as follows:
 - The WAC 2-Letter Calls Award requires confirmed contact with 2-Letter call sign suffixes located in nine (9) Canadian provinces or territories. Endorsements are available for 11, 12 and 13 Canadian provinces and territories.
 - The WAC Capitals Award requires confirmed contact with call signs located in the capital
 cities of nine (9) Canadian provinces or territories. Endorsements are available for 11,
 12 and 13 Canadian provinces and territories. All stations contacted must be physically
 within the capital city limits and this must be indicated on the QSL either by preprinted
 address or written notation, preferably the latter.
 - The WAC Combos Award requires confirmed contacts with two call signs operating as a
 valid combo in each of <u>nine (9) Canadian provinces or territories</u>. Endorsements are
 available for 11, 12 and 13 Canadian provinces and territories.

- The WAC Mobile Award requires confirmed contacts with mobile stations located in nine
 (9) Canadian provinces or territories. Endorsements are available for 11, 12 and 13
 Canadian provinces and territories.
- The WAC QRP Award requires confirmed contacts with QRP stations in nine (9) Canadian provinces or territories. Endorsements are available for 11, 12 and 13 Canadian provinces and territories. Applicants for the WAC QRP Award may certify on the application that all of the contacts were made at QRP power levels 10 watts or less. This shall be done by writing a clear signed statement on the back of the application very similar to the following, omitting or changing wording as necessary to suit the situation, "All contacts submitted were made while (I was) (the stations I contacted were) (I and the stations I contacted were) running at QRP power levels."
- The WAC YL Award requires confirmed contacts with call signs of licensed YLs in nine (9)
 Canadian provinces and territories. Endorsements are available for 11, 12 and 13
 Canadian provinces and territories.
- 8. The WAC Open Award requires confirmed contacts with at least 9 Canadian provinces/territories on a single band/mode with each of those contacts meeting meaningful & nontrivial requirements that you specify, subject to prior approval by the Awards Committee. Examples of special requirements already included in this application in the form of Specialty WAC Awards are WAC 2-Letter Calls, WAC Capitals, WAC Combos, WAC Mobile, WAC QRP, WAC YL. You are very strongly advised to ask about the acceptability of any award conditions not specifically listed before investing a great deal of time making contacts using those conditions since these awards will NOT be issued for trivial reasons, for reasons that circumvent existing requirements, or for reasons not consistent with the principles of The Club. You may earn this award multiple times for different special conditions. A WAC Open Award may be earned for 9, 11, 12 or 13 provinces/territories with any level higher than the one first earned on a given band/mode being an endorsement.
- The WAC Same Station Mobile Award consists of a certificate issued for confirmed contacts with the same mobile station located in nine (9) Canadian provinces or territories.
 Endorsements are available for 11, 12 and 13 Canadian provinces and territories.

SUBMITTING APPLICATIONS:

 After first assuring that each QSL used toward this award conforms to all of the requirements above, refer to the standard instructions contained in the application for the 100-Point Award, the SWL Award, or on our web site (Awards Program, General Information), or included with this application if it was obtained by postal mail, for submitting applications and paying awards/endorsement fees.
