- Click the 'Register' button. The following message will appear:

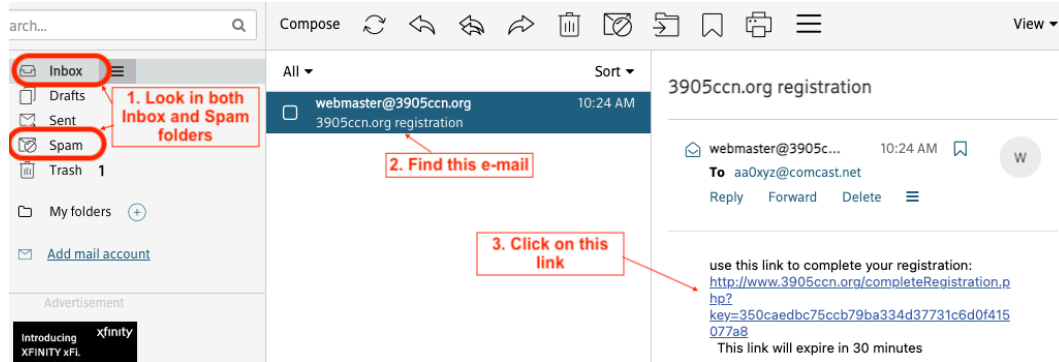

a. Check your e-mail at the email address you provided in Step 6.

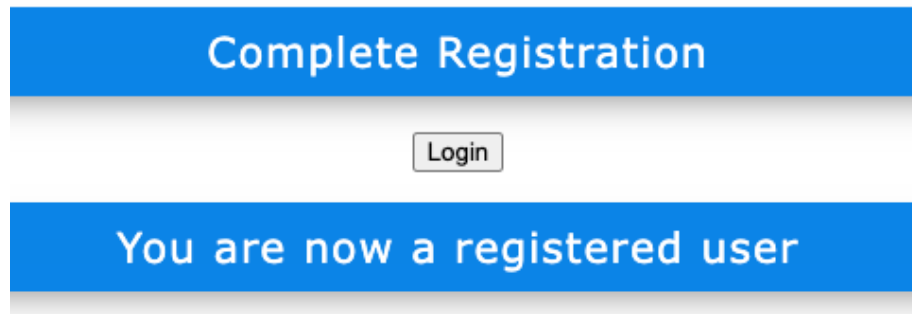


b. Look in both your Inbox and Spam folders for an email titled ‘3905ccn.org registration’.

c. Click on the link in the e-mail following the ‘use this link to complete your registration:’
